The Division office is located in Gladstone Manitoba on Highway 16, (1.5 hours from Winnipeg and 1.2 hours from Brandon) and serves a geographic area that includes the communities of Austin, Gladstone, Langruth, Macgregor and Plumas as well as a number of Hutterian communities. The Pine Creek School Division has 5 elementary schools, 2 high schools, 7 Hutterian schools, and hosts the provincial Teacher Mediated Option (TMO) course delivery in Manitoba.

We are looking for candidates who exude positivity and who are passionate about education, students and people and can take that passion into a leadership role for the Division.
