The Nisga'a School District is situated at the end of a paved highway 97 km north of Terrace, BC, a community with a Regional Airport offering regular 1.5-hour air service to Vancouver. The lands of the Nisga'a Nation are blessed with soaring mountains, dramatic lava beds and thriving rivers and streams. The natural beauty of Nisga'a lands is complemented by the rich cultural traditions of the Nisga'a Nation. There is a wealth of outdoor activities to enjoy in the area, including fishing, hiking, cross-country skiing, snowmobiling and much more. The district enrolls approximately 400 students in four schools, all located along the Nass River approximately one and a half hours apart, in the beautiful Nass Valley. District housing is available.
