The North East School Division is currently recruiting for a Superintendent of School Services. The position is located in Melfort, Saskatchewan, and comes with a competitive salary, full benefits and pension package, and learning and development support.

The North East School Division (NESD) is a rural school division located in north east Saskatchewan and encompassing approximately 11,000 square kilometres. It spans a geographic area from Naicam in the south, Smeaton in the north, Hudson Bay in the east, and Melfort in the west. The division head office is located in Melfort.

The NESD provides for the learning needs of approximately 5,000 students in 21 schools located in 13 communities. The NESD is a full service school division and one of the largest employers within the North East Central part of the province. The Division employs approximately 650 full-time equivalent staff.

The NESD is a progressive and innovative school division, focussed on ensuring every student has the opportunity to succeed. The Division has developed a strategic plan, with focussed goals and targets, to ensure that all resources are aligned to meet those goals.

Reporting to the Director of Education, the successful candidate will be a dynamic individual who promotes excellence in learning for all, with a demonstrated ability to develop a cohesive and effective team. This person will also possess the necessary management and communication skills to successfully be a leader and operational manager for staff in the assigned portfolios that include: Assessment, Curriculum and Instruction, Communications, Information Technology, First Nations Metis Inuit Education/Partnerships, Online Learning, Libraries, Career Guidance, Athletics and Home School students.
