The Board of Trustees for the Pine Creek School Division invites applications for the position of Superintendent. Duties to commence on July 2, 2019 or as mutually agreed with the successful applicant. The Board seeks an education leader to carry on the positive momentum of the Division's successes that have taken place under the leadership of our retiring Superintendent. Our Division is committed to the delivery of quality educational opportunities in schools that are open, safe and caring.

The Division office is located in Gladstone Manitoba on Highway 16, (1.5 hours from Winnipeg and 1.2 hours from Brandon) and serves a geographic area that includes the communities of Austin, Gladstone, Langruth, Macgregor and Plumas as well as a number of Hutterian communities. The Pine Creek School Division has 5 elementary schools, 2 high schools, 7 Hutterian schools, and hosts the provincial Teacher Mediated Option (TMO) course delivery in Manitoba.

The Board seeks candidates who exude positivity and who are passionate about education, students and people, and can take that passion into a leadership role for the Division. Bringing with him/her the experience of being a classroom teacher and an educational leader in the K-12 setting, the Superintendent will be someone who is creative, innovative, solution-focused, and possesses an ability to assess ideas and programs that will ultimately benefit students.

Applicants should have an understanding of rural issues and dynamics and must be able to demonstrate an ability to build relationships with students, stakeholders, and staff. The successful person will have the foresight to recognize potential in people and be able to mentor/coach people towards reaching their full potential. Candidates should be knowledgeable of educational developments, legislation requirements, and policy development. The Superintendent will have management acumen in the areas of organizational/fiscal planning and managing people resources.

In addition to the qualities above, the successful candidate will:

- Hold or be eligible for certification as a teacher in Manitoba
- Hold a Master's degree in Educational Administration or be willing to enroll in a Master's degree program with an expected graduation date
- Have an understanding of the role of technology in education
